Students must complete at least twelve hours at the 300-level or above in each of the selected minors and must achieve a grade of C or better in each course in the selected minors.

Electives to complete 124 hours:			

An area of emphasis must include the following:

1. *All the requirements to satisfy the minor in that department*
2. *At least 12 hours of 300- or 400- level courses*
3. *A minimum grade of "C" on all courses in the area*

- * *No more than one-half of your degree may be community college hours (60 hours).*
- * *At least 120 semester hours with passing grades must be completed for any Liberal Arts degree.*
- * *Choose electives carefully to make sure that a minimum of 40 hours of course work--at least one-third of the hours applied toward a degree--is at the 300-level or above.*
- * *You must attain a GPA of 2.00 or better on all work attempted, as well as all work attempted at The University of Mississippi.*

Areas of emphasis in English, History, and Sociology may be completed on the Tupelo campus. Coursework for Math, Psychology, and Education emphases is available in Tupelo but would require some coursework in Oxford to complete.
