For those reasons, it is strongly suggested that students complete this requirement with UM-Tupelo, ensuring that community college transfer credit does not exceed 62 hours and full-time status may be maintained.**

## **APPLIED SCIENCES ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR GRADUATION**

**In addition to the course requirements listed above, the following requirements for graduation apply to all Applied Sciences 2018-2019 degree programs:**

- Minimum of 120 credit hours needed for degree (developmental studies courses and repeated courses do not count toward the total number of credit hours)
- At least one-third of the credit hours required for degree must be taken at the 300 level or above (40 hours)
- Minimum GPA of 2.0 in cumulative residence course work (UM courses only) as well as in overall cumulative GPA (includes transfer work)
- No more than half of the credit hours for degree can be from a junior or community college (60 hours)
- At least 25% of course work must be taken from The University of Mississippi (31 hours)
