



Luckyday Education Scholarships *University of Mississippi*

Criteria:

1. Must be awarded to a community college student who is a rising junior (54 hours minimum). *Preference is given to secondary education students.*
2. Students must either have a composite score of 21 with no subtest below 18 on the ACT or meet the Praxis Admission Scores for teacher education at The University of Mississippi.

Appropriate scores on Praxis I: PPST (Pre-Professional Skills Tests)

Present PPST Scores Required:

READING	170
WRITING	172
MATH	169

Students who provide proof of an SAT composite of at least 860, or of an ACT score of at least 21 with no subtest score below 18, may be admitted to teacher education without the PPST. The ACT or SAT scores must be from tests taken prior to admission to college.

3. Must have a GPA of at least 2.5 on all work attempted.
4. Must submit a one page essay that demonstrates a financial need and indicates these funds will be used for college expenses.
5. Must agree to teach in a Mississippi School for Three Years.

Award:

Students who meet the criteria will receive \$4,600 per year for the junior and senior year for a total of \$9,200. *Students must also be enrolled full time. A total of 40 scholarships are available each year.*
