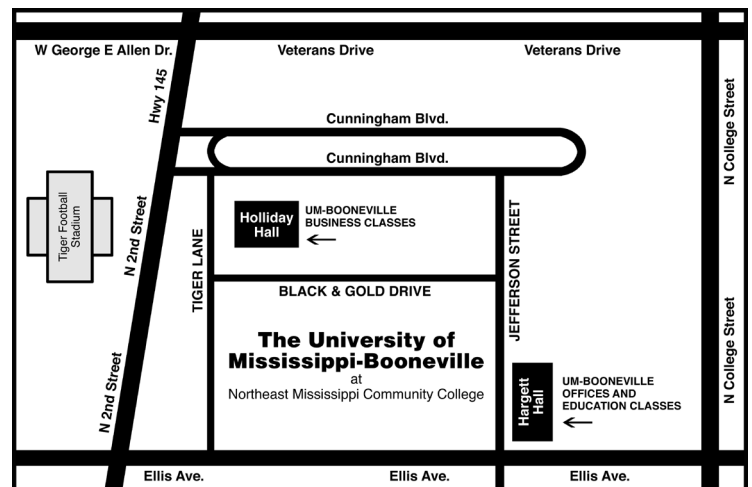

# THE UNIVERSITY OF MISSISSIPPI-BOONEVILLE: ENROLLMENT INFORMATION

**Application and Admission:** Applicants are encouraged to apply for admission online at [www.olemiss.edu/tupelo](http://www.olemiss.edu/tupelo). If you prefer a paper application, a printable form is available on the website or at the UM-Tupelo office. Mississippi residents must pay a non-refundable \$50 application fee.

Applicants for admission (undergraduate or graduate) are advised to submit the application for admission well in advance of the period in which enrollment is sought. Undergraduate applicants should have official transcripts from all prior colleges mailed directly to the UM-Tupelo campus. Graduate applicants should submit transcripts to the Graduate School on the Oxford campus. Applicants applying for the fall can find application deadlines on the academic calendar at [www.olemiss.edu/depts/registrar/acal.html](http://www.olemiss.edu/depts/registrar/acal.html). Late application may require the applicant to register after classes begin and pay associated late registration fees.

All regional students **MUST** be admitted to The University of Mississippi **before** they will be allowed to register for courses.

**Immunization Requirement:** All applicants born after January 1, 1957, must submit proof of two immunizations for measles and one for rubella prior to registration. The medical history and certificate of compliance forms are available at the UM-Tupelo office and at [www.olemiss.edu/tupelo](http://www.olemiss.edu/tupelo).

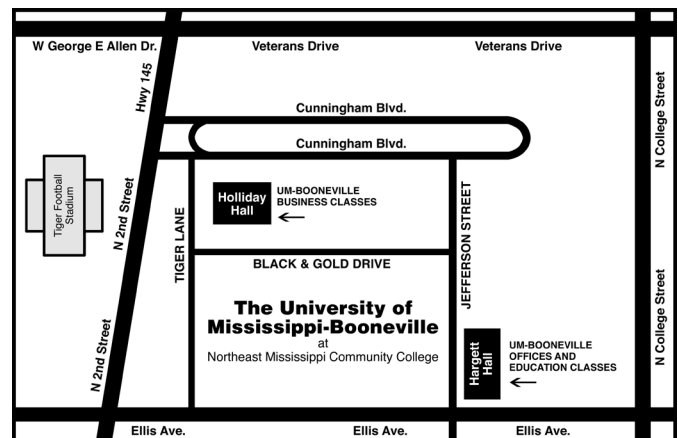
## 2026 FALL ACADEMIC CALENDAR

Classes meet one night a week (Monday-Thursday) from 6-8:30 pm unless stated otherwise.

<b>March 9-April 27</b>	Academic Advising (Fall & Winter).
<b>April 13-27</b>	Priority Registration (Fall).
<b>April 13-July 31</b>	Phase 1 Registration Period.
<b>July 31</b>	Fall Tuition & Fees Posted to Students' Accounts.
<b>August 1</b>	Phase 2 Registration. \$50 registration fee assessed this date.
<b>August 23</b>	Last day to officially cancel registration and avoid responsibility for payment of tuition and fees.
<b>August 24</b>	Classes begin; registration fee (\$100) assessed this date; 100% refund (less 5% of fees or \$100, whichever is less) on withdrawals through September 4.
<b>August 28</b>	Students may add courses on a space available basis through this date.
<b>September 4</b>	Last day to register or add classes (between August 28 and September 4 may add only with instructor's approval.) Refund period ends.
<b>September 5</b>	\$10 fee assessed per drop or add.
<b>September 7</b>	Labor Day Holiday.
<b>September 14</b>	Mandatory drop date for non-attendance.
<b>October 12</b>	Deadline for course withdrawals (no refund; refund period ended September 8).
