*Important Information: Make-up days could possibly be added on Saturday during the session or at the end of the published calendar which could include classes or exams the following week. Enrollees are encouraged to avoid making commitments that would prevent them from attending classes or exams that could be held on these make-up days if necessary due to weather or other unpredictable circumstances.

Application and Admission:

Applicants are encouraged to apply for admission online at **www.olemiss.edu/booneville**. If you need assistance, personnel at the UM-Booneville office can help you. Mississippi residents must pay a non-refundable \$40 application fee. The non-resident application fee is \$70.

Applicants for admission (undergraduate or graduate) are advised to submit the application for admission well in advance of the period in which enrollment is sought. Please mail official transcripts from all prior colleges to the admissions office in Oxford. Applicants applying for the spring can find application deadlines on the academic calendar at **www.olemiss.edu/ depts/registrar/acal.html**. Late application may require the applicant to register after classes begin and pay associated late registration fees. (See academic calendar for details.)

Immunization Requirement:


