English- 12 hours , ENG 1113, 1123 English Composition I, II , 6 hours of any survey literature (American, British, or World Lit I & II)
Mathematics- 6 hours MAT 1313 College Algebra or more advanced math PSY 2323 Stats Behavioral Science
Lab Science- 9-11 hours , CHEMISTRY, PHYSICAL SCIENCE, PHYSICS or ASTRONOMY, BIOLOGY or GEOL Choose a second natural lab science from a different department **6-8 hours in one subject area with the remaining hours from a different department
History- 6 hours , HIS 1113, 1123 (Western Civilization), HIS 2213, 2223 (US History) I or II *World History I & II transfers as US History I or II
Social/ Behavioral Science- 6 hours, any ECON, PSC (POL), PSY, or SOC
<u>Fine Art- 3 hours</u> Choose any 3- hour Art, Music, Dance, or Theatre or AH Art History course.
Foreign Language (NEMCC) or ASL (UM) - 6 hours at 200 level or above, Intermediate Spanish I & II (MFL 2213 & 2223) *pre-requisite is Elementary Spanish I & II (MFL 1213 & 1223)
Humanities- 3 hours Choose any course in PHI or REL, ENG, or MFL.
