****PLEASE READ- VERY IMPORTANT****

- 1. *You will be eligible to declare a specialty major after you have completed all Freshman level classes, plus Accounting I (<u>ACCY 201</u>), principles of microeconomics (<u>ECON 202</u>) or principles of macroeconomics (<u>ECON 203</u>), and either legal environment of business (<u>BUS</u> 250) or business communications (BUS 271). For specialty majors (e.g., marketing, management, management information systems, or finance), the GPA on these 39 hours must be a 2.25 or higher. Students who do not meet this requirement will remain in "general business.".
- 2. MAXIMUM HOURS YOU CAN TRANSFER FROM THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE IS 61 HOURS!
- 3. Please note that courses that transfer to the University of Mississippi as a 300-level course from community college will only be applied if the course is non-business in nature. Please consult the online transfer equivalency database.
