PLEASE READ- VERY IMPORTANT

- 1. *You will be eligible to declare a specialty major after you have completed all Freshman level classes, plus Accounting I (ACCY 201), principles of microeconomics (ECON 202) or principles of macroeconomics (ECON 203), and either legal environment of business (BUS 250) or business communications (BUS 271). For specialty majors (e.g., marketing, management, management information systems, or finance), the GPA on these 39 hours must be a 2.25 or higher. Students who do not meet this requirement will remain in "general business.".
- 2. MAXIMUM HOURS YOU CAN TRANSFER FROM THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE IS **61** HOURS!
- 3. Please note that courses that transfer to the University of Mississippi as a 300-level course from community college will only be applied if the course is non-business in nature. Please consult the online transfer equivalency database.
- 4. Minimum 2.0 GPA requirements in each of these areas: Cumulative GPA, Resident GPA, GPA in Major Courses, GPA in BUS/ECON/ACCY Courses, and GPA in All Courses Applied to Degree.
