DEGREE REQUIREMENTS

Successfully complete the following freshman/sophomore coursework at a regionally accredited school with a minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA*:

- 6 hours of English composition
- 6-8 hours of natural science with corresponding labs
- 6 hours of humanities (history, foreign language, philosophy, religion, classics, African American studies)
- 3 hours of fine arts (art, music, theater, dance)
- 3 hours of literature
- Economic Statistics I ("C" or better)
- 3 hours of social or behavioral science (psychology, sociology, political science, journalism, geography, anthropology)
- Calculus for Business, Economics, and Accountancy I ("C" or better)
- Calculus for Business, Economics, and Accountancy II
- Introduction to Accounting Principles I
- Introduction to Accounting Principles II
- Principles of Microeconomics ("C" or better)
- Principles of Macroeconomics ("C" or better)
- Legal Environment of Business
- Business Communication
- MIS MAJORS ONLY: Business Application Programming

Business students may apply no more than 60 community college credit hours to this degree.
