- Apply knowledge of Behavior Analysis to guide your own academic and career development.
- Reflect on your learning through daily check-ins and a final grade conference with Dr. Kate.

Who should go?

This course is open to all students with an interest in psychology, education, and related fields. It will be especially valuable for students considering graduate study or careers in Behavior Analysis, education, human services, or other helping professions.

Prior to Departure

Meet with your Ole Miss instructor and fellow classmates virtually for an introduction to course material and orientation to the conference.

During Travel

Students make their own arrangements to travel to and from San Francisco. Double occupancy hotel rooms will be provided in conference hotels, offering a convenient base for your stay. Your instructor will share exact meeting times and locations during pre-departure meetings and will be available to you leading up to the course through Blackboard. Students may have their airfare billed to their bursar account. You'll receive details upon course enrollment.

Costs

\$1,250 plus tuition, lodging/accommodation during travel, select group meals, and conference registration fee. Not included are tuition, airfare to and from destination, most meals at travel site, and personal spending money.

Once accepted to a program, the student accepts financial responsibility for Study USA program fees and tuition and must adhere to the application and withdrawal policy.
