Students will:

- Experience the rich artistic and cultural environment of NYC.
- Visit world-renowned museums, such as the Metropolitan Museum of Art, the Whitney Museum of American Art, and MOMA.
- Explore varied architectural styles of institutions, such as Frank Lloyd Wright's Guggenheim Museum and the Frick Collection, which combines the original Beaux Arts building with the recent modernist addition.
- Tour Chelsea Galleries to explore contemporary work of local, national, and international artists.
- Visit to an artist studio to see art practice in action.

Who should go?

Open to students in all majors. Designed for students interested in museums, the art world ecosystem, artists, and art historians, including those studying Art, Art History, or Museum Studies. It also welcomes any student curious about the art world, museums, and how artists, curators, art historians, and cultural organizations operate. No prerequisites.

Prior to Departure

Meet with your Ole Miss instructor and fellow classmates on the Oxford campus for an overview of the class and assignments, discuss travel logistics, and get to know one another before heading out to the Big Apple.

During Travel

Study USA will arrange air travel in and out of Memphis International Airport. Study USA will arrange all necessary group ground transportation during your travel dates, starting from your arrival at the airport. Shared accommodations will be provided at The Pod Hotel Times Square in bunk rooms with en suite bathrooms. Instructors will share meeting dates and times during orientation.

Costs

\$2,150 plus tuition, airfare to and from destination, local transportation during course, lodging/accommodation during travel, select group meals, museum admission. Not included are tuition, most meals at travel site, and personal spending money.

Once accepted to a program, the student accepts financial responsibility for Study USA program fees and tuition and must adhere to the application and withdrawal policy.
