- Gain knowledge of the histories and historiographies of the Second World War and the South
- Learn skills in conversation and critique of sources and scholarship in a range of different media
- Experience with the proposal and presentation of a work of original research
- Have insight from professionals in the field of public history

Who should go?

Open to students in all majors. Designed for students interested in the South, the second World War, local & public history, museums. Ideal for students majoring or minoring in History, Southern Studies, Museum Studies, Military Science, & Sociology. No prerequisites.

Prior to Departure

Meet with your Ole Miss instructor and fellow classmates on the Oxford campus for an overview of the course and an introduction to course topics

During Travel

Depart with your instructors and classmates from Oxford, where you'll ride round-trip to New Orleans. Your instructors will share exact meeting times and locations before travel and will be available to you leading up to the course through Blackboard. Study USA arranges any ground transportation required during the travel dates. Study USA also arranges and books lodging in double occupancy hotel rooms.

Costs

\$1,825 plus tuition, shuttle/van transportation to and from destination, local transportation during course, lodging/accommodation during travel, select group meals, museum admission, field site admission, and entrance fees to parks & attractions. Not included are tuition, most meals at travel site, and personal spending money.

Once accepted to a program, the student accepts financial responsibility for Study USA program fees and tuition and must adhere to the application and withdrawal policy.

Itinerary subject to change. Students should wait to make travel arrangements until after confirming dates and times with instructors
