- Conduct research to inform developing policy in Moss Point
- Present research findings to Moss Point community leaders

Who should go?

Open to students in all majors. Designed for students interested in Environmental Studies, coastal resilience, and community-based research.

Prior to Departure

On Campus Meeting: November 11, 2026. Meet with your Ole Miss instructor and fellow classmates on the Oxford campus for introductions and an overview of course material.

During Travel

Round trip van will be provided from Oxford, and all on site ground transportation is included. Shared accommodations will be provided near Moss Point, offering a convenient base for your stay. Your instructor will share exact meeting times and locations before travel and will be available to you leading up to the course through Blackboard.

Costs

\$1,200 plus tuition. The program fee includes shuttle/van transportation to and from destination, local transportation during course, select group meals, and daily activities listed in itinerary. Not included is tuition, most meals at travel site, and personal spending money.

Once accepted to a program, the student accepts financial responsibility for Study USA program fees and tuition and must adhere to the application and withdrawal policy.
