Students will:

Explore hallowed grounds of Virginia and Maryland, including site visits to:

- Manassas National Battlefield Park
- Antietam National Battlefield
- Fredericksburg & Spotsylvania National Military Park
- Petersburg National Battlefield

While in D.C., you'll explore more notable sites, with a suggested itinerary that includes:

- Ford's Theatre
- The U.S. Capitol
- Arlington National Cemetery

Prior to Departure

Virtual: May 12-14, 2025. Meet with your UM instructor and fellow classmates virtually for an overview and introduction to the course materials.

During Travel

Students make their own travel arrangements to and from D.C. Double occupancy hotel rooms will be provided by Study USA. Your instructor will share exact meeting times and locations during pre-departure meetings and will be available to you leading up to the course through Blackboard. Students may have their airfare billed to their bursar account. You'll receive details upon course enrollment.

Who should go?

Open to students in all majors. Designed for students interested in history, museum studies, literature, and archaeology. May interest students in ROTC, classics, political science, and foreign affairs. No prerequisites.

Costs

\$1,600 plus tuition. The program fee includes local transportation during course, lodging/accommodation during travel, select group meals, museum admission, field site admission, and entrance fees to parks & attractions. Not included is tuition, airfare to and from destination, and personal spending money.

Once accepted to a program, the student accepts financial responsibility for Study USA program fees and tuition and must adhere to the application and withdrawal policy.
