Costs

\$1525 plus tuition. Included in the program fee are shared housing accommodations, conference registration at the national NSSLHA membership rate*, and one group meal. Excluded from the cost are tuition, most meals, and personal spending money.

If students are not national NSSLHA members, an additional fee will be charged to cover the non-member rate.

Once accepted to a program, the student accepts financial responsibility for Study USA program fees and tuition and must adhere to the application and withdrawal policy.
