Students will:

- Explore environmental justice and environmental racism with a site visit to the Center for Health, Environment, and Justice.
- Meet with Congressional staff members who work on the committees that draft environmental legislation.
- Visit think tanks such as the Aspen Institute to discuss technology, economics, and the environment.
- Hear directly from PETA about the ethical treatment of animals.
- Tour the Chesapeake Bay Foundation to see a real case of ecological crisis management.

Dates/Location

Students will be in Oxford January 2-6, then travel to Washington, DC, for meetings there January 9-13.

Who should go?

This course is for students of philosophy, political science, public policy leadership, environmental studies, and international studies. There are no prerequisites.

Travel

Students will make their own travel arrangements to and from Washington, DC, and meet with the group at the hotel at a time designated by the instructor. The group will stay at the Capitol Hill Hotel, or similar accommodations.

Costs

The Study USA program fee is \$1,200. Students will also pay Winter Intersession tuition. Included in the program fee are housing, select group dinners, tours, and activities. Tuition, airfare, meals other than specific included group meals, and personal spending money are excluded from the program fee.
