DEGREE REQUIREMENTS:

1. At least **122** semester hours
2. At least **30** semester hours or residence credit in the School
3. Not more than **61** semester hours of credit from a community transfer college
4. No more than **6** of the last **21** hours may be transfer credit

Teacher Education Program Admission to Phase II:

1. Completion of core curriculum and Phase I Education Courses
2. Min. GPA of 2.75 on Core
3. Appropriate Praxis Core, SAT, or ACT scores
4. Must complete education courses with a "C" or better to move forward.
